- The basic needs of the homeless, neglected or abused in our communities have been met with coordinating donations from parishes and members for delivery to Shelters serving the afflicted.
- Donations to fund the volunteers who are assisting abused children through the legal system (a reflection
 of the stress enhanced by the COVID isolation) have come from the depths of members concern for
 others.

We all long for a return to a normal quality of life, but the creative time spent finding other ways of practicing the Corporal Works of Mercy have enriched our experience. We are awakened to work harder in our efforts to helping others!
